LRHS GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Due to the number of units required for graduation, all students are required to be enrolled in seven classes.

LRHS DIPLOMA

26 credits will be required from the following areas:

Language Arts	4 credits
<i>English I, II (EOC-R), & III Required</i>	
Social Studies	3 credits
<i>American History, World History, & American Government (½ credit) (EOC-R) Required</i>	
Mathematics	3 credits
<i>Algebra I (EOC-R) or Algebra IA/IB (EOC-R), and Geometry Required</i>	
Science	3 credits
<i>Unified Science & Biology I (EOC-R) Required</i>	
Practical Arts	2 credits
<i>Computer Applications & Personal Finance (½ credit) Required</i>	
Fine Arts	1 credit
Physical Education	1.5 credits
Health	0.5 credit
Elective Credits	8 credits
Total Credits	26 credits

- *Students must pass the Missouri and United States Constitution tests in order to graduate.*
- *If students pass the Computer Applications Proficiency Exam, it will take the place of (1) practical art credit. There are still 26 total credits required for graduation.*
- *Students may not take more than one (1) credit of physical education per year.*

All colleges/universities have set admission requirements regarding high school preparation. ***Meeting LRHS graduation requirements does not ensure you have met admission requirements to the college of your choice.***

End of Course Exams (EOC) which are required by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) include ***Algebra I, Algebra IB, Biology I, English II, and American Government***. Other End of Course (EOC) exams which may be given at the discretion of Logan-Rogersville High School include English I, American History, Geometry and Algebra II. End of Course exams (EOC) may change based on State requirements as mandated by DESE.
