EXCEPTION: By law, the filing location must be open the last day for candidate filing (Jan. 19, 2010) regardless of school closing.

Missouri's 1993 education law, Senate Bill 380, requires all newly elected school board members to complete 16 hours of orientation and training within the first year of service.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR FILING FOR
SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER**

- 1. U. S. citizen**
- 2. Resident taxpayer of the school district**
- 3. Missouri resident for one year preceding the election**
- 4. At least 24 years of age**
- 5. Eligible to hold office in accordance with Missouri law, including Missouri statute §§ 115.348 and 561.021, RSMo. Not currently serving a sentence or period of probation for a felony or a crime that if committed in Missouri would be a felony. Have never pled guilty or *nolo contendere* nor been convicted under Missouri law or the law of another jurisdiction of a felony connected with the exercise of the right of suffrage.**
